The 40 & 8 is a fraternal organization not unlike the American Legion. It was initially envisioned as a new and different level of the elite membership and camaraderie for leaders of the American Legion and had its start in March of 1920 in Philadelphia, PA. by a group of prominent Legionnaires who were members of the newly formed American Legion. Like many fraternal organizations, it was a male only membership. That changed in 2006 when woman veterans were eligible for membership but still must be Legionnaires. Then in 2008 another change was made opening membership to any honorably discharged Military Veteran or Active Duty Personnel by invitation only.

Though no longer directly affiliated with the American Legion, most 40/8 members are Legionnaires from several Posts, the VFW and elsewhere from Port St John to Sebastian.

Again not unlike the American Legion, we support a number of charitable organizations nationally and locally. Community wise, we supply Food Baskets for some of the needy families during the holiday season as well as scholarships for Nurses Training.

We thank the members of Post 117 for its support in providing a place for us to meet and for hosting our activities. We look forward to our mutually beneficial relationship in the years ahead.



La Femmes Cabane 1621

La Femmes is a national organization, chartered in 1963, celebrating our 52nd year. Our sole purpose is to support the programs and principals of the Forty and Eight, which has been chartered since 1919 by veterans returning from WWI.

Our La Femmes Cabane 1621 has been chartered since 2007 and our energies have focused on some of the 40/8 priorities, especially CHILD WELFARE to include:

- Providing continued support of Camp Boggy
 Creek, a medical camp for critically ill children
- Providing contributions to local children's charities
- Supporting timely special projects for families at holiday times

Our organization supports the 40/8 POW/MIA national program with monthly financial donations toward direct scholarships for validated veterans and direct descendants of POW/MIA. We educate and provide treatment for Hansen's Disease, (Leprosy, still a threat to Floridians) through the CARVILLE STAR, a national priority program for the 40/8 for 6 decades.

NURSE'S TRAINING has been a well-supported program, both locally and nationally, and Voiture 1621 has provided nursing scholarships to Eastern Florida State College students since inception of the local charter.


