




Every year, veterans, their families and supporters honor those who suffered as prisoners of war and those who are still missing in action on National POW/MIA Recognition Day. This special day was established formally by an Act of Congress in 1998; it is observed on the third Friday in September.

Post 117 will hold a special ceremony on Friday, 18 September at 2 pm in the entry area of the Post to commemorate this special day. Everyone is invited to participate in this brief ceremony.

Early Bird Membership

Do you need another reason to renew early? How about this? Legion Membership fees will increase on 1 January 2016. CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

Many people have heard of PTSD but may not understand what it is. Post Traumatic Stress Disorder is a common reaction to an uncommon event. It has been called many things over the centuries. In the 1600's the Swiss observed a consistent set of symptoms in their soldiers and called it "nostalgia". German doctors of the same period used the term "Heimweh" and the French called it "maladie du pays" both terms roughly translate to "homesickness". The Spanish called it "estar roto" meaning "to be broken". During the American Civil War it was called "soldiers heart", they called it "shell shocked" in World War I and "combat fatigue" in WW II, It was called "war neurosis" during Korea and in the 1970's they called it "Vietnam Veterans Syndrome".

Each of these terms show different facets of the disorder...a soldier's heart does get profoundly altered by war. Emotionally something is truly broken inside these warriors. As their family, let us continue to pray for our Veterans and their families and remember that they may not react to normal life circumstances the same way others do. More on this topic in the future....


