



In this time of uncertainty, I felt it important to publish some news that many may not be aware of. The National Executive Committee passed Resolution #3 which cancelled the National Convention and the purpose of continuity all officers, commission and committee persons stay in place until next year's National Convention. Commission and committee persons stay in place until the fall meetings. They further recommended that Departments do the same. The Department executive committee voted to follow National's lead and Cancelled the Department Convention and chose to keep all Officers in place, from District to Department Commander.

Post 117 Family Accomplishments this Year

- I. We hosted the Inaugural Veterans Day Parade followed by a community event at the post. Guests of Honor included US Congressman Posey, Space Wing Commander B/G Schiess.
- 2. Charter two (2) Scout Troops with meetings being held at the Post we further make donations to the troops averaging \$500 a quarter. The Post also sponsors two scouts from limited income families to attend summer camp. Our scouts are also a part of our Independence Day, Patriots Day, Veterans Day, and Memorial Day Celebrations.
- 3. Our Holiday Parade Entry took first place for our theme "Stars and Stripes in Lights", Honoring America, Our Military, and Veterans on this Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day.
 - a. The Ship from the Float is now mounted on the fence near the Light House
- 4. Sponsored two (2) Boys for Boys State and hosts a Picnic to raise money for transportation for the District Boys and Girls State attendees.
- 5. Had ten students compete in the post oratorical contest and the post winner was also selected for District and Eastern Area.
- 6. Provided school awards at the three (3) Schools in Palm Bay and further has the Post 117 citizenship certificate given at Elementary and Middle Schools to any student caught being a Good Citizen during the school year.
- 7. Members conducted Flag Education programs at 7 Elementary Schools in the City and pass out coloring books and Flags. Along with the Scouts we provide a Flag Drop box and ensure Flags are properly retired on a regular basis and hold special ceremonies close to Flag Day

- 8. ROTC Medals Award program at Heritage and Bayside High Schools. Each recipient receives a Medal and a Scholarship Check. The Post also has the Jose Muniz Cadet of the Year Trophy for each school with scholarship presented.
- 9. Provided a Free Breakfast to 120 Children and their families chosen to participate in the Shop with a Cop program of the Palm Bay Police.
- 10. Honored First Responders on Patriots Day (9-11) by providing meals either delivering to their duty location, the Palm Bay Emergency Room and at the Post. Over 300 meals served.
- II. Members provide 40 hours a week at St Vincent de Paul assisting with religious training and helping the homeless.
- 12. Approximately 50 hours a week for 25 weeks is spent on Cemetery Maintenance and restoration.
- 13. Post 117 is the sponsor for Hook Kids on Fishing Palm Bay with 100 children receiving a free rod, reel, and tackle box.
- 14. Family sponsors 3 Basketball teams for youth 7-17 years old, each team has 14 players.
- 15. The Post Honor Guard provided funeral honors for any Veteran in the area and at the National Cemetery. They also conduct ceremonies to retire and replace flags at local schools, businesses, and city buildings. When veteran's and service members are being returned to the local area, they responded to Congressman Posey's call for an Honor Guard to meet the plane with the families.
- 16. Auxiliary Members provide The Suds of Love for Veterans in Need laundry service
- 17. Post 117 Family placed flags at Fountainhead Cemetery each Memorial Day at the final resting place of all veterans.
- 18. We hosted (SALT) Palm Bay Seniors and Law Enforcement.
- 19. The SAL donated over \$34,000 donated to Special Olympics of Brevard
- 20. An active member of the Chamber of Commerce and was selected as the November Business of the Month.

- 22. A donation of \$500 to The American Legion Veterans and Children Foundation was presented to the National Commander.
- 23. During the Pandemic and donated \$400 in food to the local soup kitchen.
- 24. In terms of volunteer hours, financial assistance, and donated items, post 117 Family injected nearly \$150,000 into the local community.

- 32. Our membership grew over 100% for the 7th year in a row.


