As we enter 2021 The American Legion is working for Veterans and asks that you contact your Congressional Leaders to support:

- Making the Department of Veterans Affairs to authorize the engraving of military insignia for combat-related decorations on government-furnished headstones and such authorization will pertain to all combat-related decorations, including the Medal of Honor, Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross, Air Force Cross, Coast Guard Cross, Silver Star Medal, Bronze Star Medal with "V" device (for valor), Purple Heart Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge, Combat Action Ribbon and Combat Medical Badge.
- 2. And urge the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to ensure that the health-care needs of all current and future minority veterans are met; the VA increase the amount of outreach to minority veterans through awareness campaigns, benefits education and community organizations; That the VA continue efforts to focus on preventing, detecting and controlling clinical issues related to hypertension, cardiovascular care and diabetes care; and the VA continue to develop veteran-centered care initiatives for minority veterans, which can include delivery of culturally sensitive care in VA facilities; Finally, That the VA continue research that identifies causes of racial/ethnic disparities in veterans' health and health care and as evidence-based treatments develop provide interventions to reduce these disparities.
