

This year we had a Scout from Troop 732 earn their Eagle Scout rank, Anthony Franqui, and our first female Scout, Alexis Woods, from Troop 117 earn her Eagle Rank.

Alexis' Eagle Service Project was done at Baby Girl Horse Rescue and Veteran Therapy Ranch in Fellsmere, FL. Alexis led her project over 3 weekends to build a shelter, the rescue will use this shelter as an Intake shelter for new patient arrivals. Baby Girl Horse Rescue and Veteran Therapy Ranch- does just what its name says it does. They rescue large animals and these animals help Veterans and those with anxiety disorders in so many ways. This is a place where the People and the Animals rescue each other.

Anthony's Eagle Service Project was to dig up all of the vegetation and dirt from the south and east sides of the Post, put down land-scape fabric, which was then covered evenly with gravel. The finishing touch was provided by John Carlson and Bill "Pineapple" Whitney, which is the statue that now resides in the gravel near the front door. We currently have 20 Boys in Troop 732 and 15 Girls in Troop 117. Without the support of the Family at Post 117 they would not be able to accomplish all that they have done.


